### **High Volume Screening**

Our Protocol includes high volume urine screening for results within 24 hours. This technology can identify any of 17 drugs, making it one of the most comprehensive portfolios available. We customize this list for each client depending on the individual requirements of the patient/ client base.

Caribbean Medical Testing's screening menu includes but not limited to methadone, opiates, phencyclidine (PCP), THC, proproxyphene, benzodiazepines, cocaine, ethanol, amphetamines, and barbiturates. In addition, oxycodone (Oxycontin®, Percocet®), buprenorphone (Suboxone®) and other special screening test less commonly abused drugs may be available upon request.

#### **Customizable Protocols**

To better serve clients, Caribbean Medical Testing offers several protocols to meet the needs of specific markets.

These have been designed by industry experts to encompass the entire drug testing lifecyclefrom how specimen are collected to the types of tests conducted to the formatting of reports.

# Confirmation by GC/MS

Caribbean Medical Testing's Protocols include confirmation testing following the initial screen through Gas Chromatography/ Mass Spectrometry (GS/MS). This significantly reduces turnaround time and increases accuracy.

#### Medical Review

All drugs test performed by Caribbean Medical Testing are reviewed by our Medical Review Officer who is board-certified and only MRO in Puerto Rico certified by the MRO Council and the American College of MRO.

The MRO is responsible for receiving and reviewing laboratory results generated by an employer's drug testing program and evaluating medical explanations for certain drug test results. The MRO, act as independent and impartial "gatekeeper" and advocate for the accuracy and integrity of the drug testing process. Provide quality assurance review of the drug testing process for the specimens under our purview, determine if there is a legitimate medial explanation for laboratory confirmed positive, adulterated, substituted and invalid drug test result, ensure the timely flow of the test result and other information to employers and protect the confidentiality of the drug testing information.



#### Web Portal

Caribbean Medical Testing provides client realtime access to test results via its secure website. This portal contains a variety of useful tools including a status of all outstanding tests.

#### **Electronic Patient Records**

An increasing number of medical officers use electronic patient management systems. Soon insurers and regulatory agencies will require patient records to be entirely electronic.
